Treasurer's Report: As of January 6, 2023:

- * \$1,504.13 in bank as of December 31, 2022

Membership/Website Report:

- * Approaching one year since SHPC was formed (June, 2022)
- * Will have to begin the membership renewal process
- * Currently the system is set up to renew on member's anniversary date which is the day they remitted dues
- * Website will be adjusted to reflect annual membership dates begin June 1 and renew annually on May 31 regardless of when membership was activated
